



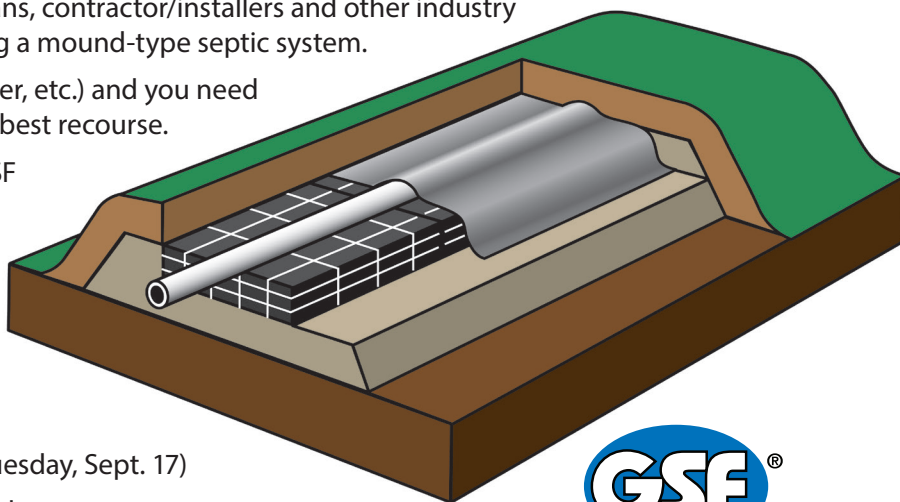
The Kansas Environmental Health Association Invites You to a Free Training Seminar on the Eljen GSF Mound System On Wednesday, September 11, 2019
